Introduction

The Remodulees platform offers a comprehensive suite of features designed to enhance user engagement and facilitate collaborative development among project partners. This introductory guide provides essential instructions on how to access the platform and its source code, ensuring that all interactions adhere to the established protocols for security and confidentiality.

Accessing the Remodulees Platform:

Users can easily navigate to the Remodulees platform by following a few simple steps. Starting with opening a web browser and entering the designated URL, users are directed to the platform's homepage. Here, they can explore various features and resources. For those functionalities that require registration, the platform clearly displays login and registration options, guiding users through the necessary steps to gain full access.

Accessing Remodulees's Source Code:

Access to the source code is restricted to ensure the protection and controlled distribution of proprietary information. Collaborators interested in obtaining the source code must adhere to a set process, which includes signing a confidentiality and usage agreement to establish a clear understanding of the terms of use. Requests for access must be submitted via email, confirming the agreement's acceptance. It is important to note that only project partners are eligible to access the source code, a measure that upholds the platform's security and integrity.

By following these guidelines, project partners can effectively utilize the Remodulees platform and contribute to its development while maintaining strict adherence to security protocols.

To access the Remodulees platform, follow these steps:

- Open your preferred web browser.
- In the address bar, type the following URL: <https://re-modulees.five.es> and press Enter.
- Once the page loads, you will arrive at the homepage of the Remodulees platform.

From here, you can explore the various features and resources available. If the platform requires registration for accessing specific functionalities, you'll find the registration or login options prominently displayed.

Accessing to Remodulees's source code

To be able to get the source code of the Remodulees platform, the collaborators must follow some rules which are made to protect and to control the distribution of this proprietary information. Here's how a partner can gain access: Here's how a partner can gain access:

- **Sign an Agreement:** The source code is not open to the public but the need to get it is fulfilled by the author of the software asking the users to sign a confidentiality and usage agreement. This guarantees that all the parties are aware and agree on the terms of the use of the source code hence, it is used as a binding contract.
- **Email Request:** After the agreement is realized, the interested partner should officially ask for the access by sending an email to esguerra@uji.es. This request should be the one that exactly tells the purpose of accessing the Remodulees platform's source code and confirm the agreement has been understood and signed.
- **Project Partners Only:** Of course, it must be mentioned that the source code is only to be accessed by the project partners. This limitation is in fact the reason for the security and the integrity of the platform.
